


Fig. 1: Cover pages of the magazines published till now




Fig. 2: ISSN of published magazines of the College

Department of History, Cinnamara College has been publishing its departmental wall magazine "Otit Dapun" every year, since 2004. It is solely published by the students of the department.




Fig. 12: 13th Edition of the Wall Magazine 2023




Fig. 15: MOU with Dr. Nabin Chandra Bordoloi College, August 31, 2022




Fig. 17: MOU with Jorhat College, September 2, 2022
