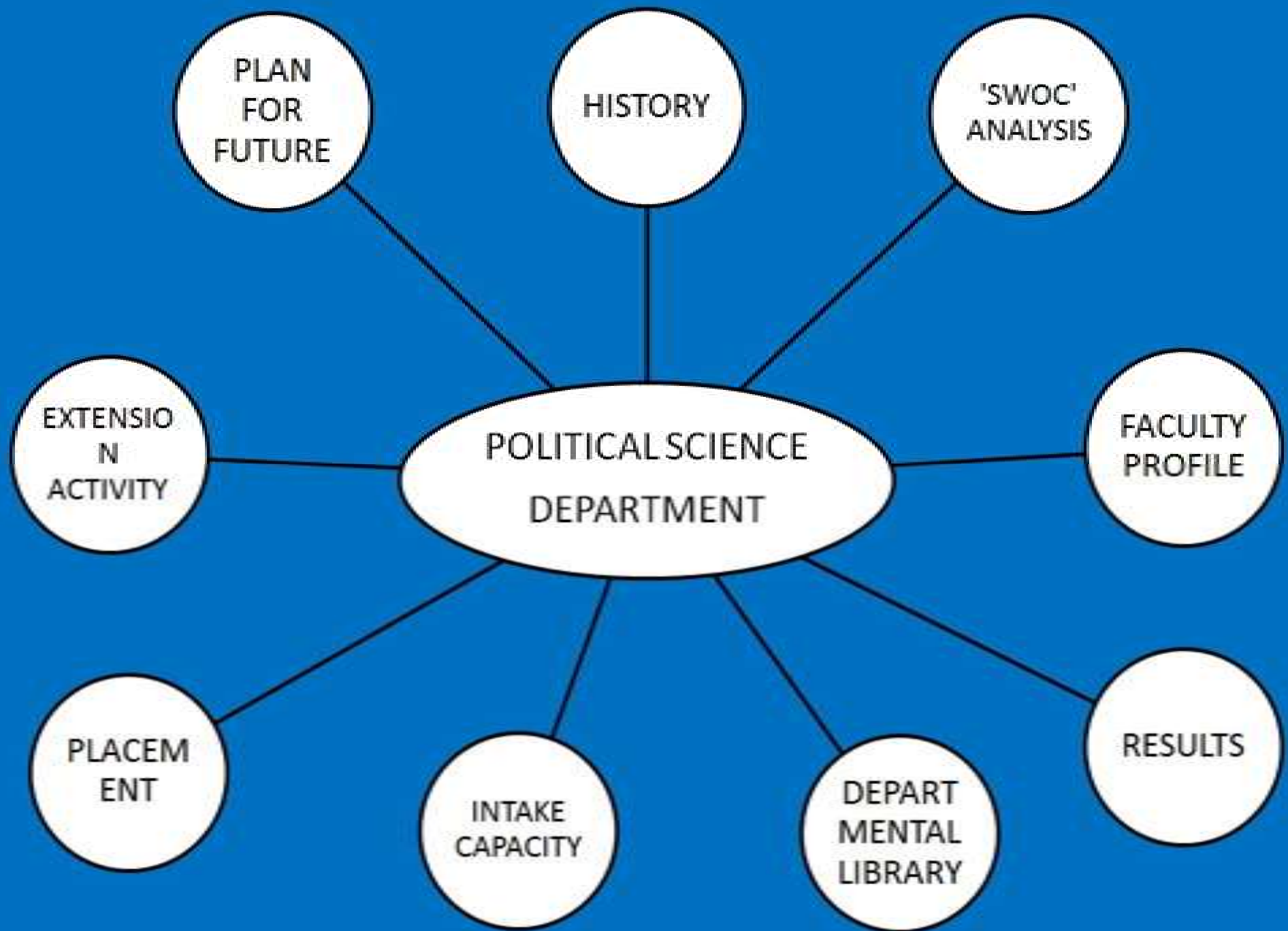

The Department of Political Science was started in the year 1992. [Mr. Ranjit Rajkumar](#) was the first Head of this department. Initially, Mr. Rajkumar was running this department with the help of other faculties till 1996. The department had started major (honours) course in the year 2007 with the noble initiative of our founder principal [Mr. Ananda Saikia](#).

The department of political science concerned which came into being with the foundation of the college in 1991. Sri Ranjit Rajkumar, Sri Jyanta Bordoloi, Sri Rupjyoti Das, Late Bandana Hazarika, Sri Dipa Dutta, Sri Gitima Bora Hazarika, Sri Dipanjali Borah Kakoti, Sri B.Tanti, Sri Siddhartha Swarup Dutta served this department with great devotion and laid sound foundation which to be raised to the present status. Initially Political Science subject was established as a general subject (non-major) along with other subjects of our college.

Although the department of political science has been functioning since the inception of the college, formal official permission for opening up Honours in the department of political science has granted by the Dibrugarh University in the year 2007 (Subject Concurrence DHE from Govt. of Assam)

Brief History

The department has student intake capacity is 40. The faculty members are devoted and actively gets involved in the departmental activities as well as of the college. The department has regularly published wall magazines, organized freshmen social, parents meet, departmental talk program, parents teachers meet, essay writing competition etc. The department is equipped with basic components like a library with 290 books catering to the needs of the students whenever required.

The department has a wall magazine *SWARAJ* which has been published since 2007 annually where students proficiency on writing, art and craft has been focused on various field they are interested to write. The student of the department are always encouraged to participate in the college events and get diligently participate in various college occasions. The departmental students are also encouraged to join NSS, NCC, Bharat Scouts and Guides Unit which are very active in our college.

Moreover the department has been published an ISSN Journal 'Swaraj' bearing no. 239-487-36 from the year 2015.

TEACHING METHOD & STUDENT EVALUATION

We use traditional teaching method and process is going on to copup with using the new IT system.Including traditional methods i.e. Lecture and Interaction with the students, using Black Board etc.

To evaluate the students, the college centrally conducts two sessional examinations for B.A. classes both for Generic Elective and Core in the month of February and April for even semesters and in the month of September and October for odd semesters. The department also conducts surprise class tests and quick revision tests on regular basis.

The students are to write the end semester examination for (each paper) 80 marks and 20 marks for internal assessment. The marks break up is as follows which includes maximum 5 marks for attendance, 5 marks for seminar / group discussion and 5 marks each from the two sessional examination held during the session.
