# About the College

## (Provincialised)

**Affiliated to Dibrugarh University**

**CINNAMARA COLLEGE** was established on 1<sup>st</sup> June in 1991 at the centre of three *mouzas* Katoni, Garamur and Charaibahi of the Southern part of the Jorhat District, Assam, near Cinnamara High School, was shifted to its permanent site on 1<sup>st</sup> June in 1998. The name of the College Campus is known as *KABYAKSHETRA*. The College Campus is located at the vicinity of ONGC, Cinnamara Complex, F.C.I. godown and opposite to Cinnamara Rly Station. The College campus is connected by its own approach road from southward (Jibeswari Katoni Path, distance only 230 meters) with Jorhat-Mariani road. The other College approach road is 'Agragami Path' from eastward (distance only 350 meters) leads from ONGC, Bagdhara road (opposite to ONGC gate) to College campus. Cinnamara is a prominent name in the growth of tea industries of Assam. Mani Ram Dewan, the martyr of the first war of independence in 1857, established his first tea garden here at Cenimora in 1846. The adjacent area of Cinnamara is known as Karanga, the hub of indigenous blacksmith craft of Assam. It is a fact that the elite section of this vast region cherished a dream to establish a college either at Karanga or at Cinnamara since the time of independence. Several efforts were made in this direction but of no avail. However, the dream of the south Jorhatians got translated into reality in 1991 when Cinnamara College was established under the dynamic patronage of Sjt. Durlav Chandra Mahanta, Sjt Mohan Ch. Katoni, Sjt. Hitendra Nath Goswami, Sjt Indrajit Kr. Barua and a dedicated coterie of social workers of the neighbouring areas. In this historic mission Sjt Ananda Saikia was undeniably the steward, the founder principal and the doyen of our College. Within a fairly shorter span of time our College has been able to showcase a conspicuous academic, intellectual, cultural and social stimulation. Our college has laid undeterred emphasis on social research through its research centre Mohan Chandra Mahanta Research Centre being established on 2nd October, 2010. In addition a unit of Sakha Sahitya Sabha registered under Asam Sahitya Sabha was also established and hopefully under the Sakha's banner we have so far published more than 179 Books and Journals having ISBN and ISSN tag. The college is also successfully conducting KKHSOU and Dibrugarh University Distance Education Study Programmes offering various conventional and professional courses. Besides, realizing the historical significance of the southern part of greater Jorhat





district, the college has started a Museum and archive in the recent past. In 2016, the college has completed its glorious Silver Jubilee celebration.

### Infra-Structure

Altogether 33 spacious permanent pacca rooms have been constructed for Common room, Class room, Boys' Common room, Girls' Common room along with spacious stage ahead of the main building. Every room is well equipped with electric fan, light etc. Besides, the permanent building complex was designed by a distinguished architect of Jorhat Development Authority in collaboration with G.B. member (Technical expert) late Hassan Ali Hazarika. The total cost of the whole project is estimated to be more than one crore. A portion of class rooms of the original project have already been constructed with financial back up extended by the Hon'ble M.P. Jorhat HPC and Jorhat Development Authority. Further, a spacious Library building has been donated by Mr. O.P. reading room attached to the same being donated by Dr. Anjan Saikia, Principal of the College. In addition to, Mr. Bajranglal Bhusha and Mr. Makhanlal Gattani, local entrepreneurs, have donated two class rooms. Mr. Harendra Nath Rajbonshi of Mangaldoi donated the entrance gate in memory of his brother late Giridhar Deka who was an ex-student of this College. Mr. Dulu Gogoi, a resident of Karanga, donated the iron gate of the entrance. Dr. Harendra Nath Gogoi, President, Governing Body, donated 2.5 Lakh in order to complete the college stage. Similarly, Prof. Ananda Saikia, founder Principal of the College has donated a room in memory of his father '*Nitaram Gaonburha*'. Another room was constructed in memory of Hemkanta Bordoloi, founder Head Master of Cinnamara High School and one of the Chief Patrons of our College under the initiative of teaching and non-teaching staff, founder Principal, well-wishers and family members of late Bordoloi. Besides, local O.N.G.C. released four lakh in order to complete a class room. In the same way, Mr. Kamal Chandra Hazarika, one of the founding personalities of our College has donated an arch in memory of his father to College. The College has also obtained MPLAB fund in order to construct building, is completed. Similarly, College received grants from UGC in order to construct the women hostel, is completed and inaugurated on 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2017. The women hostel of the college is running with 14 boarders very smoothly. A conference hall is also completed with the financial assistance of Principal, Dr. Anjan Saikia and the teaching staff of the College. In addition, local O.N.G.C. again released 9.92 lakh for the construction of multi-purposed examination hall. Above all, the government of Assam has also declared one crore for the infra-structural development of the college and out of it, 75 lakh is released.



## **FOUR YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME (FYUGP) IN CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS) UNDER DIBRUGARH UNIVERSITY.**

DIBRUGARH UNIVERSITY REGULATIONS EFFECTIVE FROM THE SESSION, 2023-2024.

The regulations shall be called the Dibrugarh University Regulations for the Four Year Undergraduate Programmes (FYUGP) in Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), 2023. The regulations shall come in to effect from the academic Session, 2023-2024, and shall be applicable to the students enrolled in Cinnamara College, which is affiliated to Dibrugarh University.

### **Objectives:**

The objectives of the regulations include conducting the following programmes:

- 1) UG Certificate
- 2) UG Diploma
- 3) Three Year UG Degree
- 4) Four Year UG Degree (Honours)
- 5) Four Year UG Degree (Honours with Research) in various fields of study/discipline as per the guidelines of UGC's Curriculum and Credit Framework in the light of NEP, 2020.

It also aims to provide multidisciplinary set-up to enable students to become well rounded across disciplines, promote co-curricular activities and active research. Moreover, it aims to provide flexibility for the students through multiple entry and exit options.

### **Learning Outcomes:**

Graduates should be able to demonstrate the acquisition of discipline-specific learning, practical, professional skills in areas of specialization. They should also be able to demonstrate the capabilities of complex problem solving, critical thinking, creativity, communication skills, analytical reasoning, research related skills, leadership skills, Digital and technological skills, values inculcation, etc.

### **Programme Details:**

- 1) UG Certificate programme after completing 1 year (2 semesters).
- 2) UG Diploma Programme after completing 2 years (4 semesters).
- 3) Three Year UG Degree Programme with single Major after 3 years (6 semesters).
- 4) Four Year UG Programme with Honours after completing 4 years (8 semesters).
- 5) Four Year UG programme with Honours and research after completing 4 years (8 semesters), with a rigorous research project.

**College/Departmental/Centre for Studies Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) Board:**

There shall be a College/Departmental/Centre for studies Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) Board to monitor and supervise the implementation of the Undergraduate academic programmes, which shall be constituted as below:

Chairperson: The Principal of the College

Vice-Chairperson: The Vice-Principal of the College

Members: Heads of the Departments and the Coordinator, IQAC

Member Secretary: A Senior Teacher of the College nominated by the Principal of the College.

**Minimum eligibility criteria for multiple entry points of the UG programmes:**

- a) **1st Year:** Senior Secondary School Leaving Certificate or Higher Secondary (Class12) Certificate obtained after successful completion of Grade 12 or equivalent stage of education and/or Admission test conducted by College/University/National Level Testing Agency/State Level Testing Agency.
- b) **2nd Year:** A certificate obtained after successful completion of 1 year (2 semesters) of the undergraduate programme. These students are to take admission in the 2nd year within a period of three years from obtaining the UG certificate from Dibrugarh University or any other University/institution recognized by Dibrugarh University.
- c) **3rd Year:** A diploma obtained after successful completion of 2 years (4 semesters) of the undergraduate programme. These students are to take admission in the 3rd year UG programme within a period of three years from obtaining the UG diploma from Dibrugarh University or any other University/institution recognized by Dibrugarh University.
- d) **4th Year (Honours):** A Bachelor's degree after successful completion of three years (6 semesters) of the undergraduate programme obtained from Dibrugarh University or any other University/institution recognized by Dibrugarh University. These students are to complete the degree within the stipulated maximum period of seven years.
- e) **4th Year (Honours with Research):** A three year Bachelor's degree with a minimum of 7.5 CGPA. The minimum entry requirement for 4th year (Honours/Research) UG programme within a period of three years from obtaining three year Bachelor's degree from Dibrugarh university or any other University/institution recognized by Dibrugarh University. These students are to complete the degree within the stipulated maximum period of seven years.

**The admission or eligibility criteria shall be fixed by the Academic Council from time to time whenever necessary. The college any also adopt own policy for admission or**

selection of eligible candidates for admission complying with the eligibility criteria as prescribed.

Statutory reservation policy of the government shall be followed in case of selection of eligible candidates for admission.

A student who has less than 80% attendance in average shall not be permitted to sit for the End-semester examination.

A student shall be entitled to take the 'Betterment Examination' in any two theory courses after successful completion of 3 year/4 year programme only once. In this case, the higher marks secured by the student shall be retained. The candidates shall have to apply for betterment examination within one year of passing the 6th/8th Semester examination. Students shall have to appear in the betterment examination with the regular batch. No betterment shall be allowed in the practical/project/dissertation/internship examination.

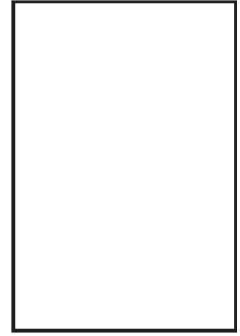
